Smoke Free Policy

The provider must promote the good health of the children, take necessary steps to prevent the spread of infection, and take appropriate action when they are ill – EYFS legal requirements

Aim of policy

To ensure that children are in a smoke free environment and all children parents, Centre users and staff are aware of the risks to health from smoking

Procedures

- **Somerville Nursery School is a smoke free environment. There will be no smoking within the school or within the grounds.**
- **Wirral Councils' smoke free policy ensures compliance with the legislation prohibiting smoking in enclosed public places, which is contained in the Health Act 2006, Part I, and five sets of regulations made under the Act. (Intranet)**
- **A smoke free environment will include the inside of all vehicles owned and operated by the Council and on Council business.**
- **The premises and vehicles must display signage that complies with the law in a prominent position at every entrance to smoke free premises so that people entering the premises can see them clearly. The signs must make clear to staff and other Somerville Nursery School users that the premises and vehicles are smoke-free.**
